Battlefield 4 announced with pre-order premiums

Strap on the Kevlar and build up your arsenal. [Battlefield 4](#) has been announced for Xbox 360, PS3 and PC.

The Battlefield series is one of the most popular game titles to be released every season alongside Call of Duty and Assassin's Creed. This game's predecessor, Battlefield 3, won [20 awards at E3](#) in 2012, including Best Shooter, Best Multiplayer and Best Graphics.

EA and DICE recently released a [17 minute video](#) of game play footage. The majority of this new game will be set in China. You will play as a soldier named Recker, fighting to rescue VIPs in Shanghai while avoiding global conflict. Expect fleshed out animations, better facial

expressions and more freedom in how you engage your enemies.

Early birds will receive some extra perks when they put money down on this hot title. GameStop is throwing in free Battlefield themed dog tags as well as exclusive bonus in-game content when you put five dollars down on a pre-order for the game. Fans will want to move quickly to snag the physical bonus. These fancy dog tags are only guaranteed while supplies last.

Wal-Mart is also offering its own premium when you pre-purchase the game. Alongside extra in-game content, customers will receive a free copy of Battlefield 3 when they pick up the new game.

The exact street date for the popular first person shooter has yet to be announced, but gamers can expect to have it in their hands this Fall.
